Kawartha Lakes RC Flyers

This code and the field rules are intended to foster a culture of having fun with model aircraft in a friendly, safe and courteous environment. (Adopted November 18, 2023)

Code of Conduct

- I will at all times behave in the safest manner possible by following this Code of Conduct, MAAC Notams and Safety Guidelines, Canadian Aviation Regulations Part IX, and applying common sense.
- 2. I will always conduct myself in a polite, courteous and responsible manner.
- 3. I will make every effort to ensure that the operation of my model does not interfere with the enjoyment of the hobby by others. I will be considerate on the field and in the air by giving my full attention to where and how I operate my models. I recognize I share these facilities with others.
- Members will conduct themselves at all times in accordance with the club's Anti-Discrimination and Anti-Harassment Policy stated in the Club By-Laws.

Field Rules

- 1. I will attach an Owner Contact Information label to my models in accordance with MAAC MPPD 10.
- 2. I will attach a Transport Canada Registration Number to my models as required by CARS IX.
- 3. I will not fly fuel powered models at the club field before 9:00 am.
- 4. I will not fly if there are currently 4 aircraft in the air.
- I will loudly announce to other pilots my intention to take off, land, or move onto or off the runway. When another pilot makes an announcement of his/her intention, I will clearly acknowledge his/her announcement.
- 6. I will use the runway most favourable to the wind.
- When more than one model is flying, I will follow the circuit set by pilots who take off before me and will only change that circuit in response to a change in the wind and only after establishing agreement with other pilots who are flying.
- 8. When others are flying, I will not move onto the runway except for the placement and retrieval of aircraft, and only then with the agreement of the other pilots. Exception for any club sanctioned event requiring runway incursions. I will be prompt. I will not fly when the runways are being cut.
- When any person is on the runway, I will maintain my aircraft at a safe altitude until the runway is clear.
- If I am a beginner, I recognize that I must be assisted by a qualified club instructor while flying at any club flying site, until I have obtained my "Wings".
- I will retain full control over my visitors or guests, particularly children and pets. I shall ensure they stay in designated areas.
- My aircraft should be inspected by another experienced modeler prior to its first flight, and after any significant repair.
- I will be courteous to our flying field neighbours and will whenever possible, seek their permission before retrieving a downed model from their property.
- 14. I will not use model rockets at any club flying site.
- 15. I will not loan out equipment belonging to the Kawartha Lakes Flyers.

Repeated or single significant violations of this Code of Conduct and/or Field Rules may result in membership being revoked or membership renewal being denied.
